DAY 1: TRAVEL LONDON - NAIROBI

Fly out from London Heathrow to Nairobi.

Fly out from Nairobi to Kisumu. Spend the afternoon settling in and relaxing at our compound.

DAY 3-8: PLAY TIME!

Every day you will work on the renovation of our headquarters, setting up the workshop and installing the playground in the neighbouring Obwolo Primary School. You will also enjoy 2 free afternoons to discover the wonders in and around Kisumu.

DAY 9: TIME TO CELEBRATE!

The highlight of your adventure will be the official opening of our new headquarters and of the playground at the local school. Bring tissues... there will be tears of joy of sure! After the celebration we will get you back on a flight to Nairobi.

Education is one of the most effective ways for people to break the cycle of poverty and our playgrounds and play-based programmes encourage children to go to school and enhance their learning.

Why Aren't Flights & Insurance Included?

We are not a travel agency so cannot include flights. However, we will guide you to ensure you book the right flight and insurance at the best price.

Will It Be Safe To Travel with COVID-19?

All our activities are risk assessed and insured and once in Kenya you will be supported by our local team. We have 10+ years' experience of delivering life-shaping experiences for volunteers including during several Ebola outbreaks and national elections! If we can't be assured of your safety then we will postpone the trip. Your safety is our primary concern at all times!

Do I Need To Be Fit?

The Kenya Legacy Project team will be engaged in manual labour such as digging, mixing concrete and painting in a hot & humid climate. It is advised that you have a good level of fitness and if at all in doubt, check with your GP before registering on this adventure.

Can I Bring My Kids?

Young adults aged 16 and over, accompanied by at least 1 guardian/parent, are absolutely welcome. Please note that children will be classed as a fully participating member of the team. They will therefore be required to help with the workshop construction and playground installation and will also need to meet the registration fee & fundraising target.





What Is The Accommodation Like?

You will be hosted at our compound in Kisumu in shared rooms and/or tents. You will be helping to get us set up so expect clean but basic conditions - but it's all part of the adventure! A once in a lifetime, incredible experience awaits you that will shape both our futures forever.

What Do I Need To Bring With Me?

We will issue you with a recommended kit list once you register. Basic provision to bring with you include mosquito repellent, anti-malarials, sun cream, etc.

What Will The Food Be Like?

Food is plentiful on the trip and will include both local and western options including soups, rice, pasta and stews. We do advise you bring lots of your own favourite snacks or items you can't go without like marmite.

How Do I Register?

We only have 12 places for our Kenya Legacy Project. To register and secure your place today, you simply need to follow the link below and put down a deposit of £275. The deposit is non-refundable about a 7-day cooling off period.
